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Children Youth and Family Services



Children's Integrated Services

Serving children and their families prenatal to 6 years old. Providing parent education and training, early childhood clinical assessment and intervention (in partnership with Lamoille Family Center).

Access Crisis Supports

Support is focused on any child 0 to 22 years of age in the Lamoille Valley that is in need of mental health services.

Emergent case management, access bed placement and coordination, family stabilization and reunification.



Psychiatric Services

Evaluation, emergent screening and ongoing medication management.

Children's Outpatient

Serving children 0 to 22 years old, and their families.

Providing clinical assessment, individual, group and family therapy, service coordination, and case management.

Services are provided through a child focused, family centered orientation.

Treatment is strength based, trauma informed, attachment focused, and grounded in family systems work.



School Based Clinical Services

Providing clinical supports to students in contracted schools.

This service is available to any school in the Lamoille Valley that partners with LCMHS:

Home and Community Based Services

Serving children at risk of higher levels of care.

Case management, therapy and community skills services are delivered intensively at first and tapered off as families goals are reached.

Intervention is generally short term lasting 6 months.

Families homes are the primary venue for treatment.

Enhanced Family Services

Serving children up to 22 years old and needing significant intervention to avoid going into residential care, and their families.

Assessment, therapy, psychiatry, case management, therapeutic foster care services are utilized to stabilize, treat, and support families.
